Hoghton Tower Sprint – Sunday 26th July 2020

PLEASE READ THIS FULLY BEFORE SENDING YOUR ENTRY

IMPORTANT - UK competitors who do not have a full ACU Road Race or Sprint licence are able to race under an ACU one day, single event, competition licence. **ONE DAY, SINGLE EVENT LICENCES ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO RIDERS AGED 70 AND OVER.** These riders will need a full Road Race or Sprint licence. If you require a full licence, please apply to the ACU in good time to receive your full licence as you will need to produce this on the day of the sprint. If you need a unique code to apply for your full ACU competition licence then please contact myself ASAP at Marshals North West can provide these for our paid up members.

STARTER ROLLERS - Please note that as in previous years, Marshals North West will provide starter rollers however they require a vehicle to power them. Riders are welcome to use the starter rollers but must provide a vehicle if they wish to use them. Please note that Marshals North West will not be providing a vehicle to power the rollers.

OVERNIGHT PADDOCK ARRANGEMENTS - Please note that we are still having the same Saturday free overnight paddock parking with the gate being open **from 3pm on Saturday and locked at 9pm** however due to changes with Hoghton Tower everyone may need to present their tickets as an official will be present overnight. Therefore please ensure that you have your tickets with you otherwise people over 16 years of age will be asked to pay a spectator entrance fee. If you are stopping overnight please note on your entry form.

DOGS - Please note that **dogs are not permitted** anywhere at this event. If dogs are found in your vehicle upon entry to the Tower or once you are in the paddock, you will be asked to leave without any refund of your entry fee. Unfortunately there can be no excuses or exceptional circumstances cannot be considered.

DRONES - During the 2018 event there were delays to the meeting while the officials of the meeting attempted to ascertain the owners of a drone which is not permitted to operate under our ACU permit. Please refrain from using drones to help us complete a very busy schedule during the day.

RUN WHAT YOU BRUNG - Due to current ACU Hill climb and Sprint regulations, road legal machines have to be separated for classification purposes and run under “Run what you brung”. These machines must be road registered, taxed & MOT’d for use on the public highway. Riders will not see a difference in the awards per cc class or how the sprint is run however due to the changes made by the ACU the road legal and race machines have to be separated on the entry form. Please refer to the Hill climb and Sprint section of the ACU Handbook 2020 for full details and the entry form and supplementary regulations for classes to enter. A copy of the ACU Handbook can be obtained from the ACU website at www.acu.org.uk.

For 2020 there will be trophies for “Run what you brung” machines. These will be for all machines up to 600cc and machines 601cc and above. The fastest three in each group over all classes will be awarded a trophy.

Please ensure that you enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope with your entry so we can send you your final instructions and entry tickets. The final results will be posted to the Marshals North West website and Facebook page after the event. Please ensure that the correct postage is applied to the envelope, and if a request for a copy of the ACU handbook Sprint section has been made, please ensure that the envelope is A5 or bigger and has the correct large letter stamps.

Final instructions, race numbers and tickets will be sent once your entry has been accepted.
