Curborough Motorcycle Twisty Sprint – Saturday 2nd March 2024

PLEASE READ THIS FULLY BEFORE SENDING YOUR ENTRY

IMPORTANT - Riders, drivers and passengers must hold a valid NORA 92 competition licence or purchase a NORA 92 One Event Competition Licence. The following annual NORA 92 competition licences are available to all riders age 8 years and older.

Basic Annual License - £55 (No Personal Accident Cover)

Advanced License - £90 (Includes Personal Accident Cover)

Marshals North West will for the 2024 season be able to offer the following NORA 92 one event licenses:

One event License - £12.50 (No Personal Accident Cover)

One event License - £10.00 provided a NORA 92 one event license card for the year has been purchased at a one off cost £1.50/year. (No Personal Accident Cover)

ACU License Holders - One event license £0.00 (bring your QR code) provided a purchase of a NORA 92 One Event License card for the year at a one off cost £1.50/year. (No Personal Accident Cover).

ACU License Holders - One event license £12.50 if a NORA 92 One Event License card has NOT been purchased. (No Personal Accident Cover).

STARTER ROLLERS - Please note that as in previous years, Marshals North West will provide starter rollers however they require a vehicle to power them. Riders are welcome to use the starter rollers but must provide a vehicle if they wish to use them. Please note that Marshals North West will not be providing a vehicle to power the rollers.

OVERNIGHT PADDOCK ARRANGEMENTS - Please note that we still having Friday free overnight paddock parking with the gate being open **from 17:00 on Friday**. Please email me and let me know if you are stopping overnight.

ENTRY TICKETS will not be issued for this event, entry will be via a register of rider entries held at the gate. Solo riders will be entitled to entry along with 2 guests (3 Tickets), three wheeler competitors will be entitled to entry along with 3 guests (5 Tickets).

DOGS – Well behaved dogs on leads are permitted at the event, they must be supervised at all times. Failure to comply with these instructions, will result in you being asked to leave without any refund of your entry fee.

DRONES – The use of **unauthorised drones is not permitted**. During a previous event there were delays to the meeting while the officials attempted to ascertain the owners of a drone.

RUN WHAT YOU BRUNG - Due to current Sprint regulations, road legal machines have to be separated for classification purposes and run under “Run what you brung”. These machines must be road registered, taxed & MOT’d for use on the public highway. Riders will not see a difference in the awards per cc class or how the sprint is run, however it is required that the road legal and race machines have to be separated on the entry form.

SPRINT STANDING REGULATIONS - This event is held under the Code of Practice and Discipline Regulations of NORA 92 Limited and modified by the Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued for the meeting by the organisers Marshals North West.

On Line Entry Notes – Having completed the on line entry form press the “SUBMIT” button is pressed either of the 2 following messages will be displayed. These messages determine if the entry was successfully sent or failed due to information missing from required fields within the form.

This is an example of a **SUCCESSFUL** entry and the rider will receive a confirmation email to his email address within 15 minutes. Please check your spam/junk mail folders.

In this case scroll back through your form looking for the prompt, “This Field is required”, which indicates field or question which will need addressing. Once you have made the corrections necessary pressing the “SUBMIT” button should result in a successful entry.

We try to reply to all entries within 2 days of receipt, the reply will be via email which will have your entry form attached with confirmed race number and entry fees due. If you do not receive an email from us please check your Spam/Junk folders for a reply from secretary@marshalsnw.co.uk , if the mail has ended up in one of these folders please accept and trust this source. If you do not receive a reply from us within 7 days please email secretary@marshalsnw.co.uk stating you have not received a reply to your entry request and we shall investigate.



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On receiving your returned entry form check the details if any amendments/alterations are required email your comments to secretary@marshalsnw.co.uk the alterations will be amended and the forms resent to yourself for checking. Once you are happy that the entry form details are correct please email confirming such (we do not require your entry form returning).

To secure your entry, payment in full should be made no later than 2 weeks after your confirmation email of your entry details or before the closing date of Friday 23rd February 2024, whichever falls first;
